PREVENTING SPREAD OF CORONAVIRUS	OHR-7

Policy

1. MWSA ensures members, staff, volunteers and visitors enjoy a healthy and safe environment at Mill Woods Seniors & Multicultural Centre (the Centre). MWSA is committed to ensuring health regulations are followed to prevent the spread of coronavirus.
2. Unless specified otherwise, the Executive Director is responsible for implementing the parameters.

Parameters

All Albertans have a responsibility to help prevent the spread of coronavirus. Everyone intending to come to the Centre must comply with the following parameters.

1. You are legally required to self-isolate for:
 - **14 days** if you returned from international travel or are a close contact of a person with COVID-19
 - **10 days** if you have a cough, fever, shortness of breath, runny nose or sore throat that is not related to a pre-existing illness or health condition
2. If you have any of the following symptoms, please do not come to the Centre:
 - Chills
 - Cough
 - Fatigue
 - Fever
 - Runny nose
 - Shortness of breath
 - Sore throat
3. Upon arriving at the Centre, your temperature will be taken. If it is above 38°C, you will be denied entry, and asked to complete the AHS Online Assessment:

4. Please bring a mask and wear it to cover the nose, mouth and chin at all times while at the Centre. The only exception is while eating or drinking.

5. Upon entering or leaving the Centre, you are required to sanitize your hands. Please bring hand sanitizer for use while at the Centre.
6. During your stay at the Centre, you must maintain physical distancing of 2 metres.
7. Non-compliance with any of the parameters will result in entry being denied or requested to leave the Centre.
